This committee has been very dynamic this past season. We have improved our program, based on the recommendations made by the Ministry of Education and Sport (MELS).

GUIDE DU MANDATAIRE SPORTIF

We have prepared the «*Guide du mandataire sportif*». This document is the reference document for those wishing to operate a sport-study organisation, providing necessary information concerning the program.

TERMS OF AGREEMENT

Renewal and signing of all terms of agreement for all sport-studies organisations has been our priority this season. The Fédération has come to agreement with 24 teaching establishments and 28 sport trustees in 16 of the 18 Quebec regions. Collaboration was excellent and we work together to improve the quality of the services offered to our athletes.

ATHLETE-TRUSTEE AGREEMENT

We have prepared a document to this effect that has been signed by all athletes registered in this program. In doing so, the athletes agree to train in accordance with the schedule and regulations set by their trustee.

SPORT BULLETIN

A sport bulletin has been devised, uniform through the province, for each one of the skating discipline – singles, pairs and dance. All sport trustees have agreed to fill these bulletins and forward them to the teaching establishment, the Fédération and the athlete. This form of evaluation allows a better follow-up of our athletes and of their performances in training. This bulletin is prepared twice a year, in December and in June. We take this occasion to thank Élise Hamel, Manon Perron, Richard Gauthier and Aimé Leblanc. They have provided valuable suggestions in the preparation of this bulletin

COMMUNICATION

In order to inform our members of the changes made to the sport-studies program, we have organised two workshops.
